



Maroon and Gold Foundation Scholarship 2019 Guidelines

The purpose of the Foundation is to invest, manage, and direct the use of funds contributed for academic programs support, facilities enhancement, and other special initiatives of benefit to the students and the district. To this end, the Foundation has established the Maroon and Gold Scholarship to support the Millersburg Area School District's current and future students.

For 2019, the Maroon and Gold Foundation will present three \$500 award. **NOTE: Scholarship funds will be awarded to the student's college or training school upon evidence of registration in an accredited higher educational institution.**

Criteria and Eligibility for Applicants

1. Applicant must
 - attend Millersburg Area School District.
 - be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
 - demonstrate community involvement, solid academics, and desires to attend college or trade school.
2. Applicants must disclose any relationship to any Foundation Board Director for this may present a conflict of interest.

General Instructions

1. DEADLINE for scholarship applications is **May 3, 2019, 5:00 p.m.** (no exceptions).
2. Refer to application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed (i.e., reference forms, evidence of GPA, etc.) Incomplete applications will not be considered.
3. If any question does not apply to you in this application please put N/A in the space.
4. Type and print legibly. Illegible applications will not be considered.
5. Recipient will be announced at the 2019 Senior Awards night program.

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly)
2. Letter of application addressed to the Scholarship Committee. The letter should contain a brief explanation about you, your future career plans and your college or study plans. (college/university/training school, intended major, and anticipated start date). Also include examples of community and volunteer service. Letter should not exceed one (1) page.
3. Essay – written by the student on the topic – ***The Maroon and Gold Foundation will be considering future projects that benefit Millersburg students. Propose a project that you feel would benefit students. Using a \$500 seed budget, explain in the essay your proposed project, an overall plan, the steps needed to complete the project, and as much detail and information you feel would be necessary to execute the plan.*** Essay must be typed. Please note: this essay topic is hypothetical and the seed budget amount is not in place of the scholarship award.
4. One (1) letter of recommendation from choice of high school teacher, administrator, counselor, employer, or individual with significant knowledge of applicant.
5. An official and recent high school transcript with cumulative GPA and a class rank.

Deadline for the application is **May 3, 2019, 5:00 p.m.** Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered. Please mail OR submit application in person to:
